

### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA/PARAMETERS FOR SUBMISSIONS

- Written by a medical professional or researcher
- Must contain a brief abstract and keywords
- Articles summarizing clinical trials must include complete information: Title, Sponsor(s), Collaborator(s), Recruiting status, ClinicalTrials.gov Identifier, Phase, Design, Primary and secondary endpoints, and results (adverse events, participant follow up, etc), if available.
- Content cannot contain statements about the product or manufacturer that could be perceived as subjective or bias.
- Submission cannot be published or under publication consideration elsewhere.
- Suggested word count: 700 to 1,000
- All submissions must adhere to the following format:
  - Main Submission Document prepared in Microsoft Word (no PDFs) or similar word processing program
  - Font: Times New Roman font, size 12, black
  - Formatting: Use double spacing throughout
  - Do not include footnotes within the manuscript body
  - All abbreviations and acronyms should be spelled out at first mention.
